

Note on Foundation Courses

As per restructured curriculum launched from July 2020 academic session, following Foundation Courses are introduced in PGDM, PGDM -Executive and PGCM programme:

- Basics of Accounting
- Basics of Communication
- Basics of Management

The foundation courses are to be completed by student in self-study mode. The learner resources will be available on LMS, which will include the following:

- Handout,
- Power point presentation,
- Recorded webinar

The assessment criteria for these courses will be as follows:

1. Foundation courses are non-credit courses
2. Qualifying the foundation courses is mandatory for the award of diploma/certificate
3. Foundation courses will be reflected in Mark-Sheet as Pass/Not Pass but marks obtained in these courses will not be added to final score
4. The assignment will comprise of 20 MCQs of 1 mark each. The duration of assignment will be 45 minutes. The student is required to score 40% marks i.e. 8 marks out of 20 to qualify the foundation course
5. Student will be given 4 attempts to qualify the course during first semester. The assessment will be conducted through LMS
6. In case the student is not able to qualify the course in 4 attempts, he / she will be allowed additional attempts by paying the applicable reappear fee
